Philosophical view-Value signifies neither a thing nor an individual, but a thought or a point of view. As such everything which is useful to an individual becomes valuable to him.

Human values are as respect, acceptance, consideration, appreciation, listening, openness, affection, empathy and love towards other human beings. Values related to the aims of human life. For the achievement of aims men frame certain notions and these notions are called values. Values are the forces that govern behaviour at the core of the personality. Behavioural dispositions of the individual are governed by value-orientations, attitudinal dispositions, and belief systems with specific reference and relevance to broader social context of the individual.
