methyl paraben as a preservative.



Make up the final volume by vehicle and stored in well closed container.

EVALUTION OF HERBAL SCRUB

To evaluate the quality of prepared formulation, several quality tests were performed.

- 1. **Colour**: The Colour of the gel scrub was observed by visually.
- 2. **Odour:** The odour of the formulation was evaluated by smelling.
- 3. Consistency: Consistency was determined manually.
- 4. **pH:** pH of 1% solution of the formulation was measured by using a calibrated digital pH meter at constant temperature.
- 5. **Washability**: Formulation was applied on the skin, easily remove by washing with water were check washability.
- 6. **Spreadability:** The spread ability of the gel was determined manually by applying on skin with hand or face gentle rub which easily spread through the skin surface.
- 7. **Sensitivity**: The formulated preparation applied on human volunteer's hand or face and observed for any side effects.
