- Font: Times New Roman. Font Size: 12 width 1.5-line spacing, 1-inch margin,
- Authors must ensure the Similarity Index (Plagiarism) of the paper that should not exceed more than 10 percent.
- Papers should be in Word Document format.
- A copy of research/review paper is required to be submitted at the time of registration.
- The paper should be in English.
