The employers are selecting the candidates who possess the specific skills directly applicable in the job role. Hence, a candidate has to focus on skill development rather than increasing the qualifications.

The SWAYAM initiative was launched by the then Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) (now Ministry of Education), Government of India under Digital India to give a coordinated stage and free entry to web courses, covering all advanced education, high school, and skill sector courses. It was launched on 9 July 2017 by Pranab Mukherjee, Honorable President of India.^{[2][3][4]} SWAYAM has been developed cooperatively by the Ministry of Education and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), with the help of Microsoft. The current SWAYAM platform can facilitate 2,000 courses. The platform offers free access to everyone and hosts courses from class 9 to post-graduation. It enables professors and faculty of centrally funded institutes like IITs, IIMs, IISERs, etc. to teach students.^{[5][6]}

SWAYAM has accumulated 203 partnering institutes, 2,748 completed courses, 12,541,992 student enrollments, 915,538 exam registrations, and 654,664 successful certificates.^[7]

SWAYAM (meaning 'Self' in Sanskrit)^[8] is an acronym that stands for "Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds"^[9]

Online mode of learning has become popular these days. The educational institutions are not able to establish the infrastructure required to provide technological aids in teaching. As the financial requirement for the same is more which is not affordable by all institutions.
